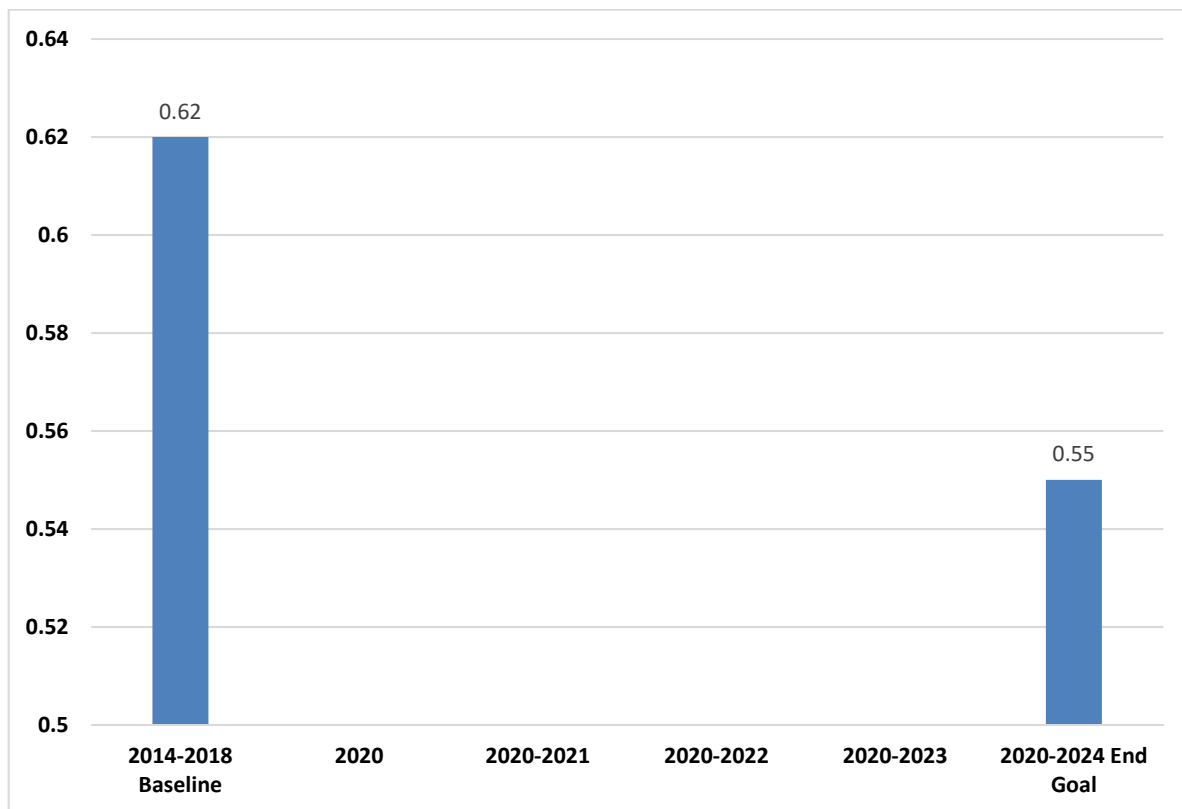

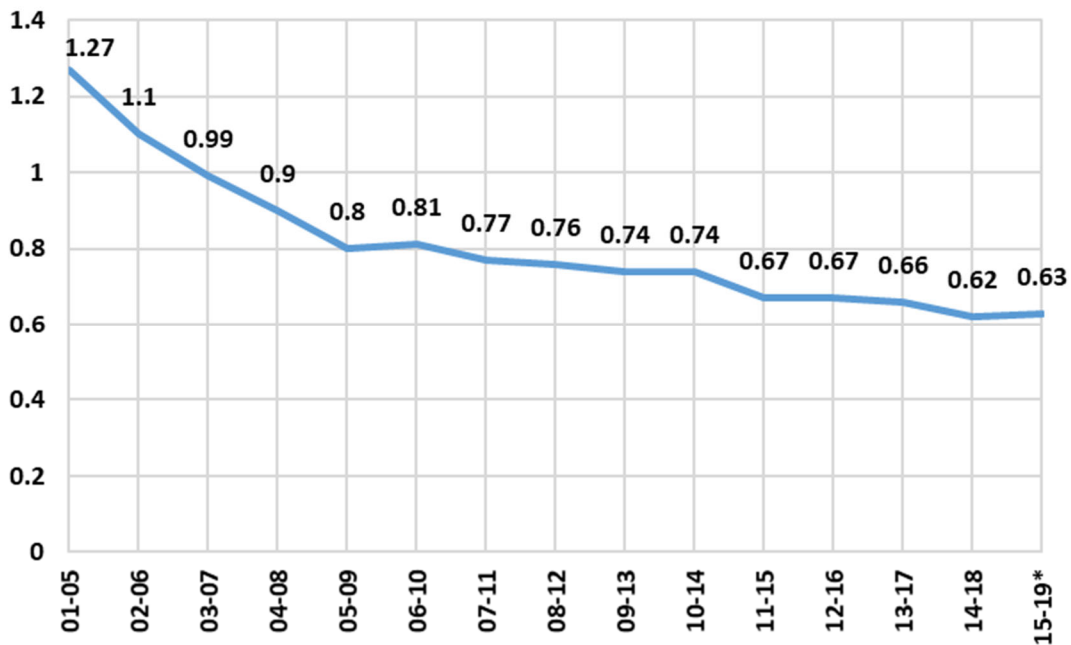
U.S. Helicopter Safety Team Goal Reduce the 5-Year Average Fatal Accident Rate to 0.55 by 2025

The baseline for measurement is the five-year average from 2014 to 2018: 0.62 fatal accidents per 100,000 flight hours.

The goal of 0.55 fatal accidents per 100,000 flight hours will be based on the five-year average from 2020 to 2024. (An 11 percent reduction from the baseline)



U.S. Fatal Helicopter Accident Rate 5-Year Moving Average, 2001-2019



The U.S. Helicopter Safety Team (www.USHST.org) focuses on the U.S. commercial helicopter community and the elimination of fatal accidents through continuous safety education and targeted safety enhancements.

Over the past two decades, the U.S. helicopter fatal accident rate has been cut in half, from 1.27 fatal accidents per 100,000 flights to 0.63. Since 2013, when the USHST was established, the fatal accident rate has decreased by 15 percent.
